### And include all of your food scraps year round!

Why keep spending \$2.75 per sticker plus the cost of bags when you can enjoy year round curbside pick up?

### What Can I Put in the Compost Cart?

All organics and food scraps (including meat and dairy items) and yard waste. See back for more details.

### How do I sign up?

### When and how do I get a cart?

If you sign up before the 20th of the month a cart will be delivered to your home by the end of the current month. If you sign up after the 20th you will receive a cart the following month. Along with your 64-gallon cart, an under the sink caddy will be delivered.

### When is compost/yard waste picked up?

Compost is picked up every Tuesday, April 1-November 30 and every other Tuesday Dec. 1-March 31.

### What does it cost?

The subscription cost is \$18 per month, which is a little more than one yard waste sticker and bag per week but includes all of your food scraps and yard waste!
