### Message from the Village President



Dear River Forest Residents,

Welcome to March. This usually is the busiest month for Village Trustees and staff as we add the finishing touches to next year's budget. This will be much of the focus of my message for April. Until then, I'd like to bring your attention to the following items.

This past Monday at a regularly scheduled board meeting, I delivered my [State of the Village](#) address and focused on a number of matters related to our guiding principles: safety, stabilizing property taxes and strengthening property values. My comments also touched on some initiatives that will improve our overall quality of life.

Trustees passed a [resolution](#) naming River Forest a Dementia-Friendly community. We become the fifth governmental agency in Illinois to be so recognized by [Dementia Friendly America](#). The Village had many partners in this endeavor, including River Forest Township, Concordia University, [AgeOptions](#) and others.



In the coming months you will see a lot of discussion around the question of aging in place. So let me explain what that is and, more importantly, what it can be. River Forest will look at how we can create programs and services that will help integrate seniors into as many facets of life here as possible. As the chair of the Mayor's Caucus subcommittee on this issue, I will be bringing ideas and solutions back to River Forest. Aging in place is vital. As we know from US Census figures, our population is growing older and because of this, we will need to offer the support that will help our aging residents maintain a high quality of life. In 2017 nearly 16 percent of our community's residents were over the age of 65; 7 percent of our residents were over the age of 75.

Now on to other matters.



The Plan Commission will conduct a public hearing at **7:00 PM on Thursday, March 7, 2019** on our updated [Comprehensive Plan](#). This document will guide present and future development, redevelopment and growth of the Village and establish a long-range vision for the entire Community. I encourage you to attend this important meeting and learn how our community can progress in the coming years. The Board of Trustees will be taking up the Plan Commission's recommendation regarding

adoption of the Comprehensive Plan later this spring.

## Help the River Forest Fire Department Find Your Home



The River Forest Village Code mandates that address numbers for all buildings be plainly visible and legible from the street fronting the property. ## River Forest Police Department Child Safety-Seat Inspections

Motor vehicle crashes remain a leading cause of death for children under age 13. In Illinois, one out of four children who die in crashes is unrestrained. Researchers estimate that proper use of federally-approved

car seats could reduce child deaths by 71 percent and injuries by 67 percent.

If you have a car seat in your car make sure it is installed and utilized properly. The River Forest Police Department offers free child safety-seat inspections. ### District 200 to abate \$5.8 million in property taxes

The Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) has announced that Oak Park and River Forest High School District 200 is one of 28 Illinois school districts that are now eligible to receive a Property Tax Relief Grant.
